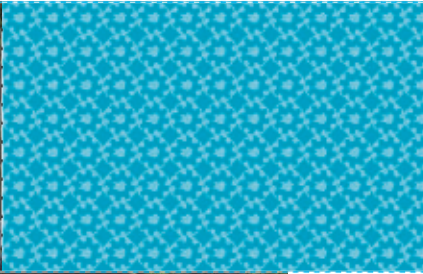

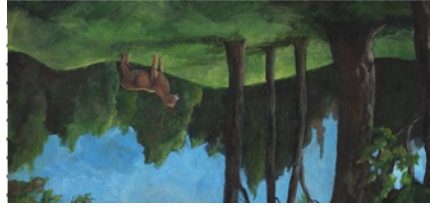

I am going to get that lion.

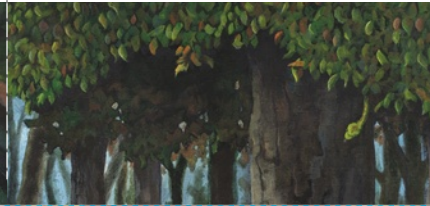


This mountain lion will harm people.

Better get to my ship.



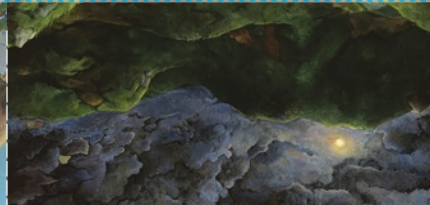
There's my house.

The next morning I went to get an apple.



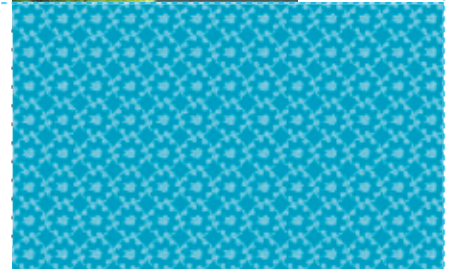
Also my bird.

"Yes!! I shot the moutain lion my mission is finished!!



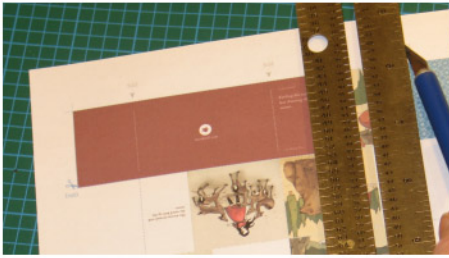

Assembling your mini Storybird

cut



Score along all the vertical gray lines (use a butterknife for safety or the back of a craft knife for precision).



Cut along all the horizontal blue lines (use scissors for safety or a ruler and craft knife for precision).



Cut along the remaining blue lines and you should have a sheet that looks like this.

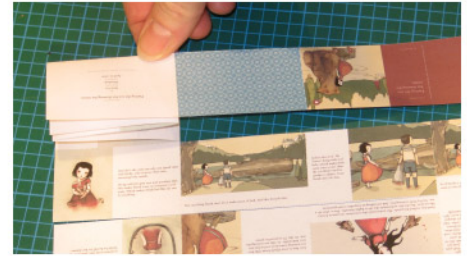
fold



Begin folding horizontally at the title page.



Accordion fold the rest of the row.



Your first accordion folded row should look like this now.

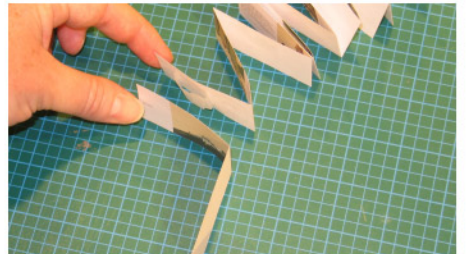

Fold down horizontally to get to the next row and accordion fold that row. Repeat.



You should have a booklet that looks like this now.

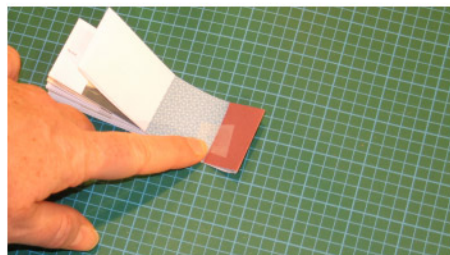


If you've got more "pages of pages", assemble them and tape the back of the first set to the first page of the next set.

cover



Fold the front cover as shown.



Wrap the front cover around the booklet and tape the flap around the last page.



Voila! Your completed mini Storybird should look like this now!
